LEGISLATION:

Law no. 95/2011 authorised Italy’s ratification of the Convention on Cluster Munitions. The Italian instrument of ratification was deposited on 21 September 2011.

The date of the Convention’s entry into force for Italy is 1 March 2012.

Law no. 95/2011 modified the provisions related to the management of the Fund for Humanitarian Demining (established by Law no. 58/2001), allowing the funding of projects specifically related to cluster munition clearing, in addition to antipersonnel mines and explosive remnants of war.
