Procurement of explosive ordnance is strictly regulated. Explosives and ammunition have to meet highest possible technical standards in particular with regard to reliability and safety design and are purchased only after successful conclusion of appropriate tests. Both manufacture and trade are subject to specific technical and legal conditions as well as regular control.

Austria uses state-of-the-art storage facilities and implements appropriate stockpile management and surveillance measures.

Safety of all personnel involved in handling, transport and use of explosive ordnance is ensured by a variety of in-house training programs ranging from recruits' training to professional EOD training.

Austria has established high standards for the procurement and storage of explosives. Most of the provisions are stipulated in national laws and regulations of the Federal Ministry of Defence. These provisions are binding for the storage of ammunition as well as the training of personnel. Training of personnel is regulated in special curricula.
