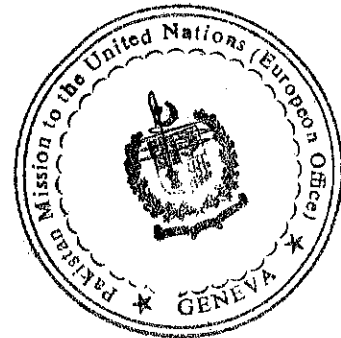

MINE CLEARANCE PROGRAMMES:

- a. Mines laid during escalation of 2001-2002 on Pakistan's Eastern border have been completely cleared/removed/destroyed.**
- b. Pakistan at present faces no problem of uncleared mines since no mines have been laid by Pakistan Army after the above mentioned escalation.**
- c. Casualties have, however, occurred due to Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs) used by the terrorists. During the period under reporting, a total of 1596 IED attacks including some APMs and Anti Tank Mines (not of Pakistani origin) were attempted by terrorists all over the Country. Out of these, 1132 IEDs (70.9%) exploded causing casualties.**
