SheTrades

An app from the International Trade Centre that connects women entrepreneurs with buyers across the world, helping them to grow their businesses and build new partnerships.

SanctionsApp

An analytical tool that can be used in real time by both scholars and practitioners interested in examining, or working on designing and implementing UN targeted sanctions, managed by the Programme for the Study of International Governance at the Graduate Institute, Geneva.

IOM emergency manual

Designed to provide practical, operational guidance to IOM staff working in emergency contexts. Content of the manual is publicly available, except for internal guidelines on management and administrative processes, so it can be used as a resource by all humanitarian actors.

UN Jargon Buster

A searchable, offline glossary that clarifies hundreds of UN terms and acronyms with terminology from a number of PCP Partners including IOM, UNIDIR, UNIDO, UNOPS and UNRISD, compiled by UNU-MERIT.

UNECE stats App

This tool, designed as an offline pocket book, presents 3,200 datasets of UNECE statistics on various subjects, such as the economy, forestry, gender, transport and development, collected from national statistical institutions.


