International cooperation on mine clearance (in 2010)

In the year 2010 the Netherlands spent an amount of 9.65 million Euros to NGO's DDG, HALO, HIB, MAG and NPA. Through UNMAS the Dutch contribution in 2010 totalled 10 million USD. An indicative overview of the Netherlands contributions to mine action in the year 2010 is stated below. Most of these funds are intended for mine clearing operations ; a smaller part is devoted to victim assistance and mine education.
