No ERW exist in Pakistan. However, at times IEDs attacks by terrorists in FATA are reported as ERW. Therefore, existence of ERW needs to be distinguished from sporadic IED incidents undertaken by the terrorists. During the period under report terrorists carried out 446 x IED attacks involving use of mines as well.
