Information regarding the commitments and obligations set forth in the Con-
vention on Certain Weapons was issued to the armed forces by letter on the
22nd of July 1996.

During training all military personnel are informed that Denmark, in accor-
dance with the CCW, no longer uses anti personnel mines or booby-traps.
All personnel – military as well as civilians - participating in observer missions,
humanitarian, peacekeeping, and other operations, etc. have prior to their de-
ployment, completed relevant mine awareness training.
