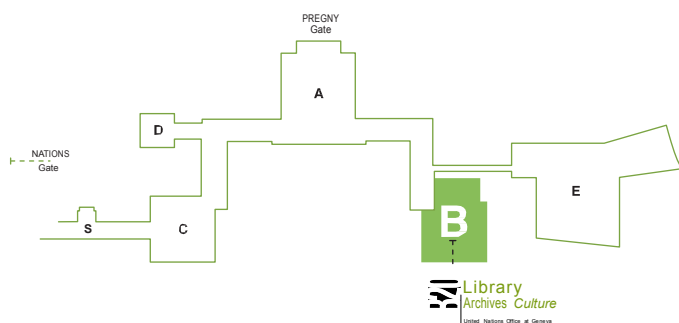


Services for Students and Researchers

Access

The Library is open to university-level students and other interested researchers upon demand. You can request regular access to the Library upon presentation of official documents and after the Library approves your request. Please send your request to library@unog.ch

Registration

Once on site, you can register for a User account at UNOG Library which allows you to borrow material but to be consulted on site only. Visit the Loans desk on the 1st floor of the Library.

Online requests

Upon registration you will receive a log in to connect to our online catalogues <http://libraryresources.unog.ch/global> and place online loan requests. Books will then be made available for consultation in one of the reading rooms. The Library material cannot be brought outside of the Library.

Reading rooms

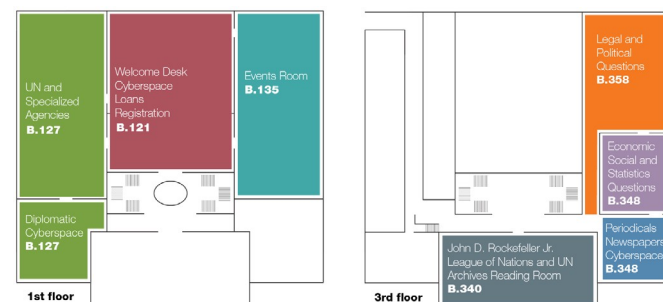
The Library offers several reading rooms with working spaces. A seat number allows to keep the borrowed material.

Cyberspaces

Cyberspaces with computers are open from 8:30 am to 5:30 pm on the 1st and the 3rd floors. They give access to Internet, office programs and the Library catalogues and electronic collections. Printers, photocopiers and scanners are also available on site.
