

## UN-REDD

The UN-REDD Programme partners with over 64 developing countries to reduce, through REDD+, the more than 11% of the world's carbon emissions caused by deforestation and forest degradation – and to realize valuable social, environmental and economic benefits.

## WTO

In some countries, import tariffs on climate-friendly products such as solar water heaters are still over 20% compared to the world average tariff of just 9%.

WTO provides the forum to discuss trade and environment-related issues.

## UN-WATER

Higher temperatures and changes in extreme weather conditions are projected to affect availability and distribution of rainfall, snowmelt, river flows and groundwater, and further deteriorate water quality.

## UPOV

Plant breeders develop new varieties that can grow under heat, drought and flood stresses, which may arise from climate change.

## ISO

ISO has produced over 570 environment-related standards including those that monitor climate change, quantify greenhouse gas emissions and promote good practices in environmental management.

## ITC

In 2015, ITC ran workshops for 200 women from six associations on climate adaptation in the raffia supply chain in Madagascar.

## UNDP

In 2012, UNDP launched the Renewable Energy Generation Project in the Gaza strip through the installation of solar panels in schools, healthcare and water facilities.

## UNRISD

UNRISD research reveals a triple injustice. Those who are the most harmed by climate change are the least responsible and often bear the brunt of the climate change response.

## CERN

The CLOUD experiment uses CERN's infrastructure to investigate aerosols and their effects on clouds, helping us to better understand climate change.

## WMO

The World Meteorological Organization monitors the climate change system, coordinates research and promotes operational services to increase our understanding of climate change and our coping mechanisms.

## GCSP

The GCSP offers a course on "Climate Change: Security Challenges and Solutions" and teaches climate change modules in other courses. It will soon host a public discussion on "Climate Change after Paris: Security and Sustainability in Practice".

## UNECE

Thanks to the Convention on Long-range Transboundary Air Pollution, emissions of main pollutants have been cut by 40% to 70% since 1990 in Europe and by 30 to 40% in North-America, contributing to climate change mitigation.
