Steps taken to implement the provisions of Article 3:

The clearance, removal and destruction of explosive remnants of war (ERW) within the territory of Hungary is the responsibility of the EOD unit of the Hungarian Defence Forces (HDF), according to the 1999 Government Regulation. In 2013, there were 2630 EOD incidents registered at the EOD unit of the HDF, where 52 027 pieces of ERW's were destroyed. The total weight of the destroyed ERW's is 17 665 kg. Most of these ERW's were remnants from World War II. During the EOD missions the unit, 283 hectares of territory were cleared from Unexploded Ordnance (UXO).

Steps taken to implement the provisions of Article 5 and the Technical Annex:

The EOD unit of the HDF provides ERW awareness presentations and training for other law enforcement and disaster control organizations, such as police and fire brigades, to make them aware to identify ERW's, about the effects of UXO's and to inform them about the correct way to mark and report them to the EOD unit. The EOD Regiment also provides ERW presentations about the identification and the effects of UXO's in schools in the most ERW affected regions of Hungary.
