In the year 2008 the Netherlands spent an amount of 10 million Euros to NGO's DDG, HALO, HIB, MAG and NPA. Through UNMAS the Dutch contribution in 2008 totalled 13,5 million USD. Most of these funds are intended for mine clearing operations ; a smaller part is devoted to victim assistance and mine education.
