Mine clearance programmes

Jordan has adopted a Comprehensive Mine Cleaning Program with the outset of 1993 and in accordance with the following priorities:

- Mine Fields that block the way of the National Economic Projects
- Mine Fields in the vicinity of populace areas
- Mine Fields in the vicinity of tourist and archaeological areas
- Mine Fields in the vicinity of/ within the agricultural areas
- Areas expected to contain mines and unexploded ordinance

Up to now, (500) fields with (286453) different mines have been accomplished.

Rehabilitation programmes

- The Royal Medical Services takes the responsibility of assisting Mine victims.
- The National Committee for Mine Clearance and Rehabilitation was established in 2000.
